

WAPHA HIGH POINT HANDBOOK

EFFECTIVE FROM 1/8/2025

This handbook helps WAPHA members track their points, learn about available awards, and understand the criteria for this season.

Our show season runs 01 August to 31 July each year. The WAPHA offers a versatile range of competition, clinics and practice shows. We aim to encourage members at every level.

To be eligible for a WAPHA End of Year High Point Award,

- 1. you must be a financial member of the WAPHA. Point calculations will be awarded from the date of your renewal of membership. *Except for the Annual High Point Working Cow Horse and Western Dressage.
- 2. compete at a minimum of 2 WAPHA shows.

WAPHA, WA QUARTER HORSE ASSOCIATION (WAQHA) & PERTH REGIONAL APPALOOSA CLUB (PRAC) show points are automatically included in the WAPHA End of Year High Point Awards calculations. WAPHA have also included awards to recognise Paint/Paint Bred horses that are showcasing our breed in other competitions and disciplines outside the Western Show Arena. Check out the qualifying criteria in this handbook for more information.

Since 2023 WAPHA have offered The Champions of Champions awards for members of registered Paint, Paint Bred, Appaloosa, Quarter Horse and Other Registered Breeds.

The WAPHA committee has the discretion to change or alter awards or eligibility criteria throughout the season. As our association continues to grow, we may introduce, or revise awards offered.

- 7. Breed / Agricultural Shows Single Points
- 8. If a tiebreaker is required, it will go on the number of first placing, then second placing if that can't be determined.
- 9. Halter:
 - a. Champion receives 1 point, Reserve ½ point.
 - b. Supreme will receive 1 singular point.
 - c. Futurity/Feature Halter classes are non-points scoring.
 - d. Please note that show programs offering combined Champion/Reserve of all sexes and Supreme Champion, the Supreme Champion points will not be awarded.
- 10. Submitting points relating to events that are not run by the WAPHA, WAQHA or PRAC are your own responsibility, and a points/result sheet accompanied with a show program must be submitted within 14 days of the show to wapha.committee@outlook.com. WAPHA reserve the right to review the program of events and accept them if they meet the criteria for each award.
- 11. Point books can be purchased from the Paint Horse Association of Australia.
- 12. PHAA approved show points are submitted to the PHAA by the WAPHA on your behalf.
